WHAT ARE EACH OF YOUR ROLES WITHIN DIVINE SAVAGES?

Tom (*right*) is our creative director. Most days you'll find him drawing – creating bold prints and patterns for our wallpaper and fabric collections. Jamie (*left*) looks after the business side of things: working with suppliers, networking and running our social media. It's great that we have such different roles and strengths as we complement each other really well.

WHERE DO YOU FIND INSPIRATION? Both of us love Art Deco and 1920s decor, and many of our designs have been influenced by this period. The natural world also features heavily in our designs. We get inspired by exploring museums and exhibitions, and by travelling.

HOW DID THE COLLABORATION WITH THE NATURAL HISTORY MUSEUM COME ABOUT?

Many of our designs take inspiration from the world around us, so it felt like our brands shared a lot of DNA already. We got in touch with the team to discuss ideas and soon learned they were keen to expand their presence within interiors. We're really proud to partner with the museum for their first-ever wallpaper collection.

DO YOU HAVE A FAVOURITE DESIGN FROM THIS COLLECTION? AND DO YOU PLAN TO USE ANY WITHIN YOUR HOME?

It's so hard to choose a favourite. Tom loves dinosaurs, so Extinctopia has a special place in his heart. As for Jamie, if he had to choose just one, it would be Forbidden Bloom. We'll be using Hierarchy in our hallway, as the Blush colourway will work perfectly with our Farrow & Ball Middleton Pink walls, then we'll start work on our new garden studio where another one of the wallpapers will definitely be featuring.
